Narcissi Tete-a-Tete
(Cyclamineus)
6" – 7" inches tall
Reflexed buttercup-yellow perianth and darker yellow trumpet. Early blooming. 2-3flowers per stem. Terrific for drifts as well as forced pots.
Zones 4-8



Narcissi Erlicheer
(Double Tazzeta)
12"-14" inches tall
Double white blossoms with light yellow flecks. 15-20 florets per stem. Great naturalizer. Very fragrant. Draught tolerant.
Zones 3-8



Narcissi Ice Follies
(Large Cupped)
Circa 1963
18"-20" tall
4" flower naturalizes. White petals around yellow crown that turns white.
Zones 3-8



Muscari armeniacum
Grape Hyacinth
4"-6" inches tall
Circa 1878 Native to Turkey
Naturalizes. This original Blue Grape Hyacinth is bright cobalt blue. Normally deer proof.
Zones 5-8



Leucojum aestivum
Summer Snowflake
12"-15" tall
Deer/rodent proof. Umbels of pendent, bell-shaped milky white flowers with faint green tip and strappy, grass-like foliage. Moisture tolerant. Strong long lasting variety.
Zones 4-9.



Ipheion uniflorum
Wisley Blue Star Flower
3"-6" inches tall
Circa 1836 sweetly scented
Naturalizing star-shaped flowers are deep blue. Plant 4" apart 4" deep
Blooms early to late Spring
Zones 5-9



Allium
A. schubertii
16" tall
Circa 1896, this heirloom has 12" clusters of rose-purple florets from ½" to 8" long for a fireworks-like appearance.
Zones 5-8



Dutch Iris Blue Magic
18"-22" inches tall
Dutch Iris were hybridized in the early 1900's from a 16th century native Spanish variety. Deep heliotrope-blue with yellow blotches. Linear form
Blooms late Spring
Zones 5-8



Hyacinthoides hispanica
Excelsior Spanish Bluebells
12"-15" tall Very adaptable.
Circa 1601. Produces 15-20 bell shaped flowers on long stems with strap-like foliage. This 1906 award winner is blue violet with darker marine-blue mid veins. Shade tolerant.
Naturalizes. Zones 4-10



Conca d'Or Orientpet Lily
Plant 6 inches deep
Height 4ft. to 6ft.
Bright lemon yellow with ivory petal margins
Fragrant, sturdy stems
Drought tolerant once established
Zones 4-8
